Total Disability	Total Disability means that due to Injury or Sickness the employee is unable to perform all of the material and substantial duties of the employee's regular occupation, and the employee's disability earnings, if any, are less than 20% of the employee's predisability weekly earnings.
Partial Disability	Partial Disability means that during the elimination period the employee is able to perform some, but not all, of the material and substantial duties of the employee's regular occupation. After the elimination period, partial disability means that due to Injury or Sickness the employee is able to perform some but not all of the material and substantial duties of the employee's regular occupation, and the employee's disability earnings, if any are at least 20%, but less than 80% of the employee's pre-disability weekly earnings.
Pre-Existing Condition Limitation	3/12 - A Pre-Existing Condition is a Sickness or Injury for which you have received treatment within 3 months prior to your effective date. Any disability contributed to or caused by a Pre-Existing Condition within the first 12 months of your effective date will not be covered.
